IIC EDI Claims Release 3.0 Trading Partner Tables, Version 1.8, Available for Download

IIC has posted the EDI Claims Release 3.0 Trading Partner Tables, Version 1.8 that are immediately available for download at https://iicedi.info/requirements. The 'Requirement Tables Change Log' describes the changes to IIC's Requirements. We do not anticipate any further changes to the EDI Claims Release 3.0 Trading Partner Tables prior to implementation on November 4, 2017.

Highlight of Changes on V1.8:

Please see the Idaho Track Change Log for the details on the changes. These changes are the results of feedback based on testing by the trading partners and IIC.

- DN0015 Claim Administrator Claim Number: Idaho will now allow embedded spaces.
- DN0228 Return to Work with Same Employer Indicator: Modified the FROI Conditions to consider DN0189 Return to Work Type Code = A.
- DN0077 Late Reason Code: Modified the FROI Conditions as Idaho statute requires that the injury be filed within 10 days of it being a reportable injury or event.
- DN0017 Insured Name: Requirement Changes and Condition added.
- DN0184 Insured Type Code: Requirement Changes.
- DN0216 Other Benefit Type Code Error: 042 Not statutorily valid: Correction to indicate that 421 and 422 are not accepted on the Population Restriction
- IIC Implementation Guide Section G updates
