Idaho Industrial Commission (IIC) Announcement

Important Reminder: Trading Partner (Direct Reporters Sending R3 Data Format) and EDI Vendor Testing for Mandatory Reporting has begun!

Date: May 16, 2017

This is a reminder that the testing period for IIC Trading Partners (Direct Reporters) and EDI Vendors for testing IAIABC Claims Release 3.0 started on May 5, 2017.

IIC is currently reviewing the registrations received/not received. For the companies that have not registered, IIC will be contacting them directly to request completion of the IIC Trading Partner Profile Registration. The IIC Trading Partner Profile Registration(s) must be completed in order for testing to begin. If you have not yet registered as a Trading Partner, you must register now. To register, go to <https://iicedi.info/register>. IIC requires each entity, including those who plan to use an EDI Vendor, to complete the Electronic Trading Partner Registration. The Trading Partner Registration provides pertinent information to IIC about the Sender, Receiver, Insurer and Claim Administrators and transmission protocol.

IIC EDI Trading Partners submitting Claims data directly in R3 Data Format and EDI Vendors are required to complete the Test Plan. The IIC Test Plan can be found at <https://iicedi.info>, select Implementation Info.

Exceptions: No testing is required for IIC Web Entry filers. In some cases, if a Trading Partner is using an EDI Vendor, the EDI Vendor will coordinate and/or perform the testing on behalf of the Trading Partner.

Please note the following important information regarding the test files coming in:

- Must have proper information, coincident with method approved on Trading Partner Profile
- Test/Production Indicator (DN 0104): Located in position 82 of the Header Record should be set to 'T' for all testing.

IIC will return acknowledgments to the Trading Partner during the testing phase(s). Processing is usually done the same day but no longer than 48 hours after the data is submitted with consideration for test file format issues or other unexpected processing issues.

Testing for Mandatory Reporting ends October 13, 2017 and Mandate Date for IIC EDI Claims Release 3 is November 4, 2017.
