Highlights of IIC EDI Implementation Guide Changes on V2.2:

IIC updated I. SECTION ONE: FORWARD subsection *G. Idaho reporting requirements* discussed on pages 8, 9, 10 and 11 including:

- Filing requirements related to lump sum settlements.
- Guidance for reporting alleged fatality claims before compensability is determined.
- Guidance for reporting claimant's death.
- Guidance for reporting Permanent Partial Impairment.
- Clarification regarding claim acceptance.
- Reiteration of the in-state claims administrator's responsibility to address claim filings.

Highlights of Trading Partner Tables Changes on V2.2:

- Idaho SROI Sequencing Table: Added Processing Note "S14" to ER, PD, PY, RB, RE
S14 reads: SROI MTC EP and IP are allowed to follow if no previous SROI MTC EP or IP accepted.
- SROI Event Table: Added the MTC S9 Suspended Pending Settlement Approval event.
- Please see the Idaho Track Changes Log for complete details (Item# 2.2.1 through Item #2.2.15). These changes are the result of feedback received from trading partners and IIC.
